- Obsolete Stocks Management

For each of the above areas, Vision 2020 provides a specific vision, strategy, key actions together with key performance indicators.

While cropLife maintains a lifecycle approach to stewardship, other activities undertaken during research, manufacturing and storage phases are not covered in Vision 2020 as they pertain to the R&D level.
